**ADDENDUM NO. 01**

The *Philippine International Convention Center (PICC)*, through the *Approved Budget for CY 2024 and Multi-Year Contracting Authority (MYCA)*, intends to apply the sum of **TWO MILLION TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND PESOS (Php2,250,000.00) VAT Inclusive**, being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for the **Three (3) – Year Subscription of Sangfor Firewalls 5300 & 5600 series (Maintenance Support) (PICC APP 2024–MC-142)**.
