Invitation to Re-Bid for the Supply of Labor and Materials for the Repair of Operable Partitions at Meeting Rooms 2/3

- The Philippine International Convention Center (PICC), through the Approved Budget for CY 2024, intends to apply the sum of ONE MILLION ONE HUNRED EIGHTY-SEVEN THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED EIGHTY PESOS AND THIRTY-TWO CENTAVOS (Php1,187,380.32), VAT Inclusive, being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for the Supply of Labor and Materials for the Repair of Operable Partitions at Meeting Rooms 2/3 (APP2024-MC-18). Bids received in excess of ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
- 2. The *PICC* now invites bids for the abovementioned requirement. Bidders should have completed, within at least five (5) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the abovementioned requirement. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II (Instructions to Bidders).
- 3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184.
- 4. Prospective Bidders may obtain further information from the *PICC-BAC* and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below during office hours.
- 5. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by prospective bidders starting September 7, 2024 from the given address and website(s) below and *upon payment of a non-refundable fee in the amount of Two Thousand Pesos (Php2,000.00)*. A bidder shall present its proof of payment for the fee *by furnishing the PICC-BAC a copy of the Official Receipt*.
- 6. The PICC-BAC will hold a Pre-Bid Conference on September 16, 2024 at 1:30 p.m. at Function Room B, 2nd Floor Secretariat Building, PICC and/or through videoconferencing/webcasting via Zoom/Google Meet, which shall be open to prospective bidders.
- 7. Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat through manual submission at the office address indicated below, on or before *September 30, 2024 at 1:00 p.m.* Late bids shall not be accepted.
- 8. All Bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in **ITB** Clause 14.
